As an Eagle Scout himself, he proudly mentored the first group of Eagles for Troop 2600 in Decatur, GA, as Assistant Scoutmaster and is the current Community Steering Committee Chair for the Atlanta Area Council's Soapstone Ridge District. A cultural arts enthusiast, Mills is in his third year as Founding Chair of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra's Advisory Council, focusing on broadening the ASO's inclusiveness across Atlanta's diverse communities.
