He is a Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations and a member of Business Executives for National Security, a nonpartisan nonprofit focused on addressing the national security community's most pressing challenges. Mr. Blum is a board member of the Greater Austin Chapter of the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame. Mr. Blum is a graduate of Leadership Austin's Emerge Program. He is the Chair of the American Enterprise Institute's Enterprise Club group in Texas and serves on the Enterprise Club's National Board. Mr. Blum is a member of The Fifty, a board affiliated with the Seton family of hospitals.
