Lois K. Folger is President of Folger Energy LLC, a private independent exploration and production company she founded in 2004 focusing on Permian Basin assets.

Mrs. Folger has over 30 years of energy experience beginning her career as a field engineer for Texaco Inc. At Texaco, she held various engineering positions and authored technical papers on reservoir management and enhanced oil recovery. In 1997, she joined the start-up Concho Oil & Gas

Corporation where she led oil and gas acquisitions and asset development resulting in the sale of the company to Devon Energy in 2001. She then joined the newly formed Concho Resources Inc. where she directed asset growth until the company was sold to Chesapeake Energy in 2004.

Mrs. Folger serves as a Trustee for the University of Notre Dame, as President and Trustee of the Catholic Charitable Foundation, and as Vice Chair of the Cockrell School of Engineering Advisory Board.
